
DEP Bulletin

The DEP Bulletin is published on a semi-monthly basis by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and contains a list of construction permit applications recently filed or acted upon by the DEP. Interested persons can determine the status of: COASTAL Area Facility Review Act (CAFRA) permits, Federal Consistency Activity permits, Federal Dermits, Open Water Fill permits, Solid Waste Facility (SWF) permits, Stream Encroachment (SE) permits, Tidal Wetland permits, Waterfront Development permits, Treatment Works Approvals (TWAS) and New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NJPDES) permits.

The DEP Bulletin is in Adobe Acrobat PDF format. To view it, you need to download a free Adobe Acrobat reader from www.adobe.com (see below). When viewing the Bulletin on screen, some text may appear as gray lines due to its small size. To view this text, use the magnifying glass tool on the Adobe Acrobat toolbar to zoom in on the text. To print the Bulletin, use the printer icon on the Adobe Acrobat toolbar. Do not use the File/Print function within Internet Explorer or Netscape.

With this unique application, homeowners can find out what's in their backyard; and environmental organizations, planners, and builders can identify open space, various regulatory boundaries, sensitive lands, watersheds, and much, much more. This application was last updated <u>July 2005</u>.

Although the application is very user friendly, you might want to first review the <u>Tutorials</u> before diving in. Then take it for a test drive and see for yourself how much environmental information you can access. The amount of information available increases as you zoom in closer and closer on a particular area. This information, called "data layers," can be seen to the left of the map. After you have created your map, you can print it for future reference.
