Through the Municipal Adopt-A-Storm Drain Assistance program municipalities would enlist volunteers (either as individuals or associations) to adopt and monitor catch basin conditions. Upon adoption, public works personnel will be responsible for labeling the basins with unique identification numbers or codes. Municipal residents who adopt a drain will be given guidelines for simple inspections of the drains and asked to notify their Public Works Department if any problems are found.
